- 1. Why did the Crusades begin and what was so important about Jerusalem?
- 2. What did Pope Urban II have to do with the First Crusade and how did he sell his idea to the people of Western Europe?
- 3. Who was targeted by the Crusaders while heading to Constantinople and what was their justification?
- 4. Briefly explain the relationship between Urban II and Emperor Alexis I.
- 5. Why would Urban II agree to help Alexius?
- 6. When the Crusades arrived outside Constantinople, why was Emperor Alexius I furious?

7. What was Alexius expecting to receive when he called for aid from Urban II?

- 8. What did Alexius finally do with the Crusaders and how did he eventually "manipulate" Duke Godfrey of Guillon and his brother Baldwin?
- 9. Why did the Crusaders want to seize Antioch prior to moving on toward Jerusalem and what would have been the likely result if they had not taken Antioch?
- 10. How did Bohemond finally make entry into Antioch, fostering the eventual Christian takeover?
- 11. In your opinion what were the true reasons for the Crusades and how is it viewed in the West and Islamic society?
